**1 MUSEUM OF APPALACHIA & LUNCH:** Our Amazing Animal adventure begins at Museum of Appalachia, a living mountain village and working farm in the Southern Mountains. See farm animals in their natural setting, wander through authentically furnished pioneer cabins and enjoy exploring the cabins, gardens, and displays of the farm and village. Before our tour, we sit down to a full Tennessee country lunch. **L**

**2 KENTUCKY HORSE FARM TOUR • ARK ENCOUNTER:** Beautiful horse farms have been part of the bluegrass since the region was first settled. This morning we visit one of the horse farms, a unique bluegrass kind of experience you'll long remember. Our knowledgeable guide will make sure you don't miss a hoof beat. This afternoon, we "board" the Ark, a one-of-a-kind historically themed attraction. Bigger than your imagination, the Ark brings the Bible to life offering three floors to explore as the largest timber-frame structure in the world. We have dinner on our own before traveling to Indiana for our overnight stay.

**3 EXOTIC FELINE RESCUE CENTER • HARDY REINDEER RANCH • DINNER & SHOW:** Visiting the home of over 200 exotic cats is a rare and unusual opportunity to say the least. The Exotic Feline Rescue Center gives us the chance to join their vision of rescuing felines that have been abused, abandoned or for some reason have nowhere to live out their lives, while helping us to learn more about these beautiful cats. Prepare for some lively fun at Hardy Reindeer Ranch. Starting out with only two reindeer, the Hardy Ranch is now home to 16 reindeer flown all the way from Alaska. You'll hear the 'clickity click' of their big hooves and find out just why people fall in love with them. We enjoy a buggy ride around the farm to get a closer look at these magical animals of the north. We enjoy a chuckwagon BBQ dinner, complete with tin plate and mug. **D**

**4 GRANT'S FARM WITH LUNCH • THE BUTTERFLY HOUSE • ST LOUIS:** Let's begin our day with a big step... like a Clydesdale step! A popular St. Louis destination since 1954, Grant's Farm is the 281-acre ancestral home of the Busch family, named for Ulysses S. Grant who originally worked a portion of the land. Now home to over 50 Clydesdales that vary in age from six months to fifteen years or older, we can come face to face with these leg-ends, get cheek to beak with a parakeet or even bottle feed a baby goat. Climb aboard the tram for a leisurely ride through the farm before or after your lunch. Then, we fly over to the zoo, the butterfly zoo. Imagine more than a thousand live tropical butterflies flying freely in an 8,000 square foot glassed room. No visual obstructions, just beauty in flight. At the Butterfly House,

we can watch a butterfly emerge from a chrysalis right before our eyes or visit native and migrating species in the Butterfly Garden. Bring your cameras for this picturesque stop! **L**

**5 PURINA FARMS • ALPACA FARM TOUR • DINNER - LAMBERT'S THROWN ROLLS:** Well, we've seen wild cats, horses, reindeer and even butterflies. Today, we visit some four-legged friends in the canine species. At Purina Farms, we see some amazing dogs performing unbelievable stunts filled with frolics and flips. We take a wagon ride and even get to milk a cow. Then, we are introduced to an unusually soft but strange-looking animal, the Alpaca. Raising alpacas for their hair has become a very important business since their fibers are even softer and more durable than wool. Listen for the soft, humming sound of this friendly and beautiful creature. Then, wash your hands and get ready to catch some rolls, some flying rolls. Our included dinner will be filled with excitement, delicious food and rolls flying as our servers toss fresh, hot yeast rolls our way. **D**

**6 TENNESSEE SAFARI PARK • CHATTANOOGA:** The lovely state of Tennessee opens the door to our next animal adventure. At the Safari Park, Tennessee's drive-thru zoo, we can pet and feed over 80 species of animals, from antelope to zebra. Rare and endangered animals are showcased throughout this large farm. We climb onto to Safari bus for a 3.5 mile drive through roads taking us among animals from around the world. Then, take a walk through the zoo area and see primates, exotic birds, tapirs, cranes, and much more. We travel on to Chattanooga tonight for our overnight stop.

**7 TENNESSEE AQUARIUM • HOME:** Our Amazing Animal tour would not be complete without our aquatic friends. Welcome to the Tennessee Aquarium, home of over 10,000 fresh and saltwater species. Experience a remarkable journey from the mountains to the sea as you explore above and below the surface in the Aquarium's two buildings. Penguins, turtles, sharks and more fill the tanks for us to enjoy! We've seen so many amazing animals and had so much fun. Now it's time to head for home.
